The Rockbound Highland Home Program is a group of exclusive benefits for USMA graduates, their families and guests and assists in navigating post security procedures, offers access to select MWR facilities and services, and provides insider tours for graduates and their guests.

## Grad Pass

WPAOG offers a new, convenient way for grads and their guests, without DoD identification cards, to navigate the increased security regulations now in place. They can request a "Grad Pass" in advance of their visit by completing an online application and allowing the post security team to conduct a mandatory background check. Passes will be available for pick-up upon their arrival and will also allow access to select MWR facilities and services.

## Grad Insider Tours

Grad Insider Tours allow graduates to travel back into their past and reflect on their days in gray. WPAOG has arranged for grads and their guests to visit locations not available to the general public. Depending on the selected tour time, tours could include stops at the Cadet Mess, Thayer Award Room, Jefferson Hall, Arvin Gym, the Cadet Uniform Factory, and the Kenna Hall of Army Sports in the Kimsey Center.
