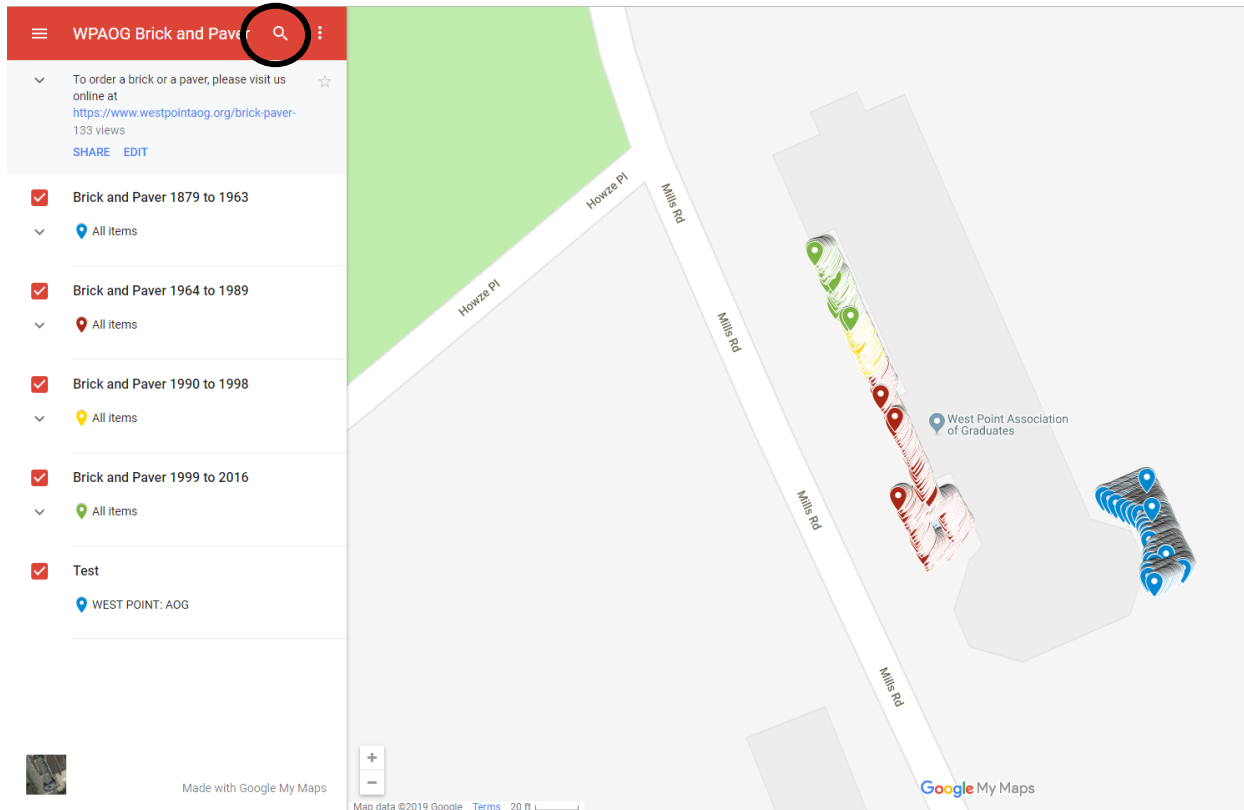




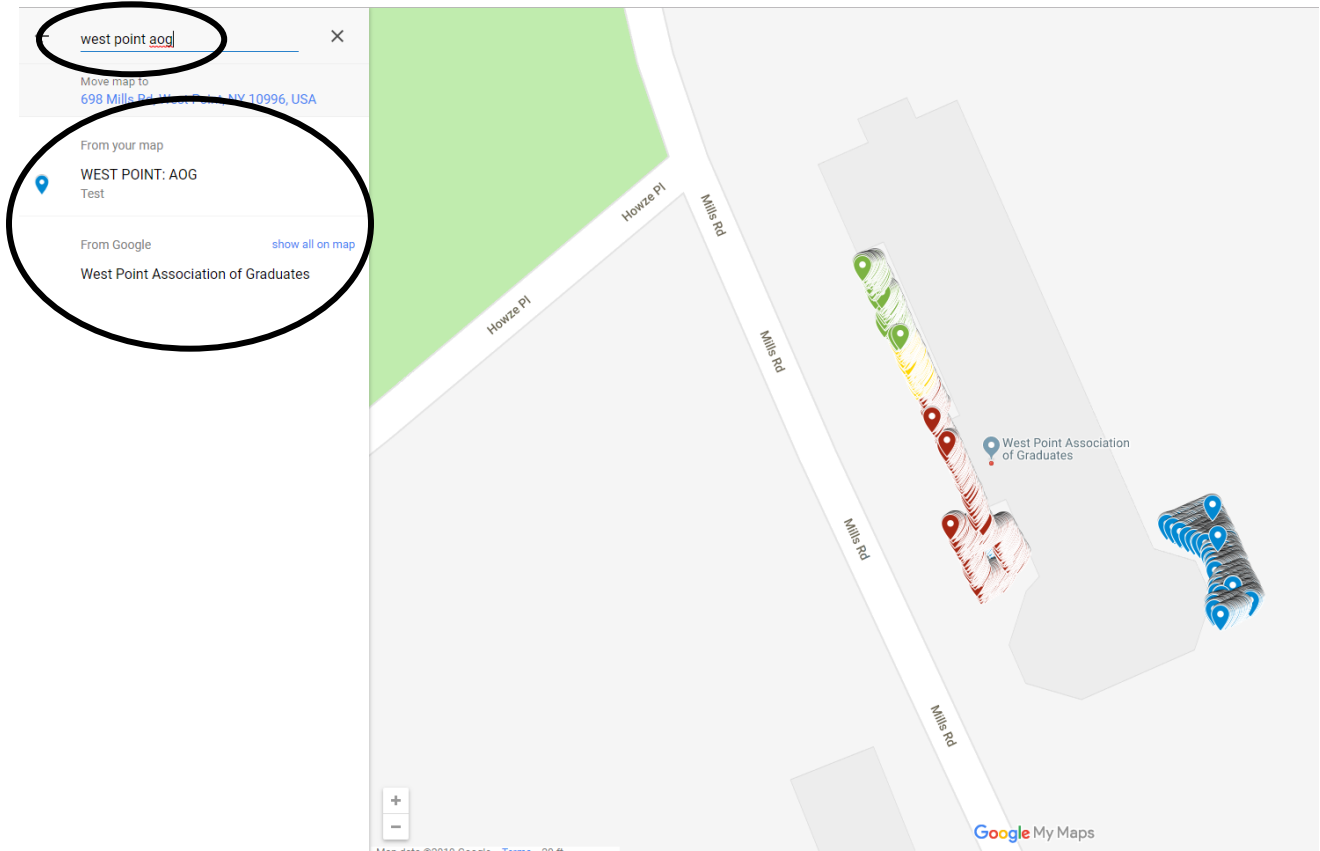
How to use the Brick and Paver search tool on the computer:

1. Select "Locate Your Brick" at <https://www.westpointaog.org/brickandpaver>.
2. In the search bar, type the recipient last name or inscription of the brick for which you are searching.



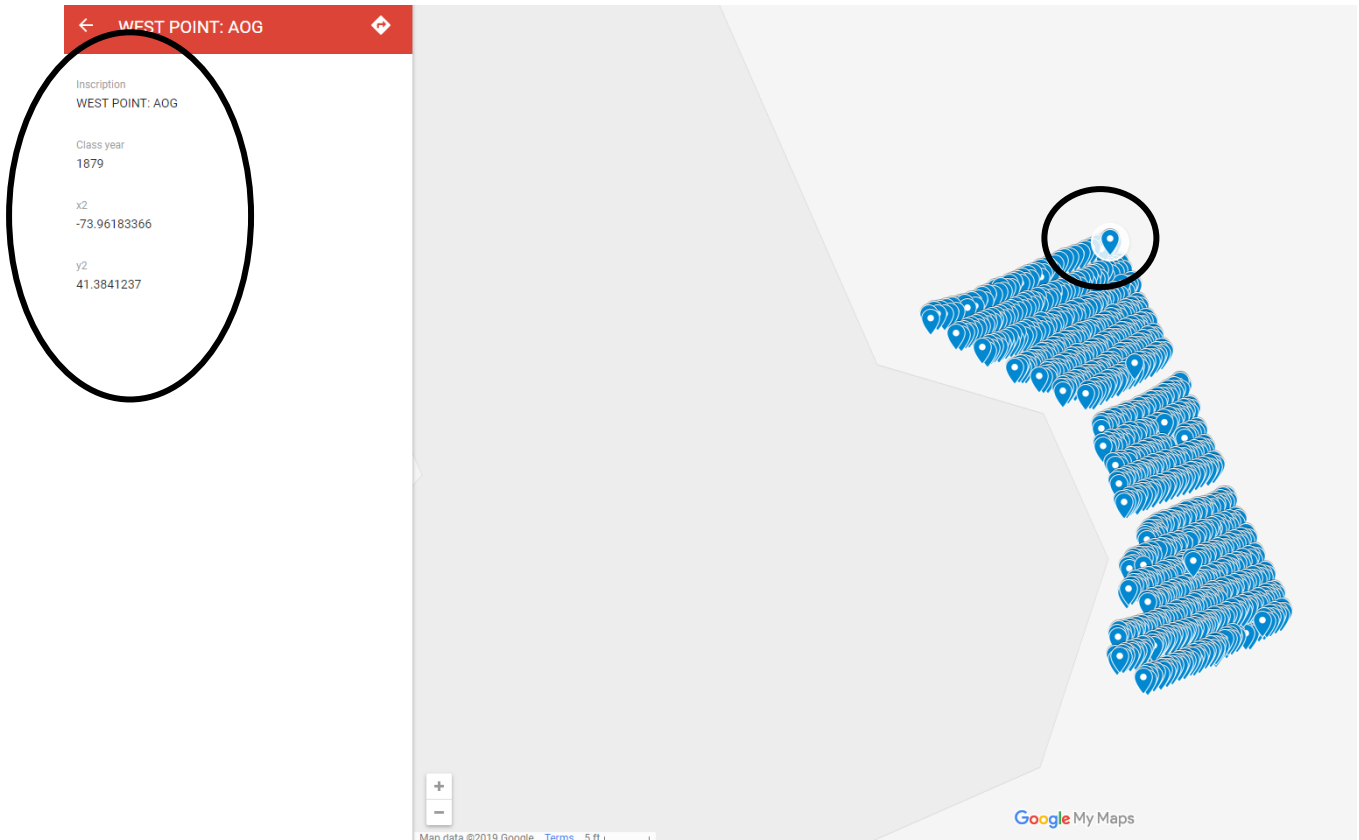


3. Select the brick you wish to locate.





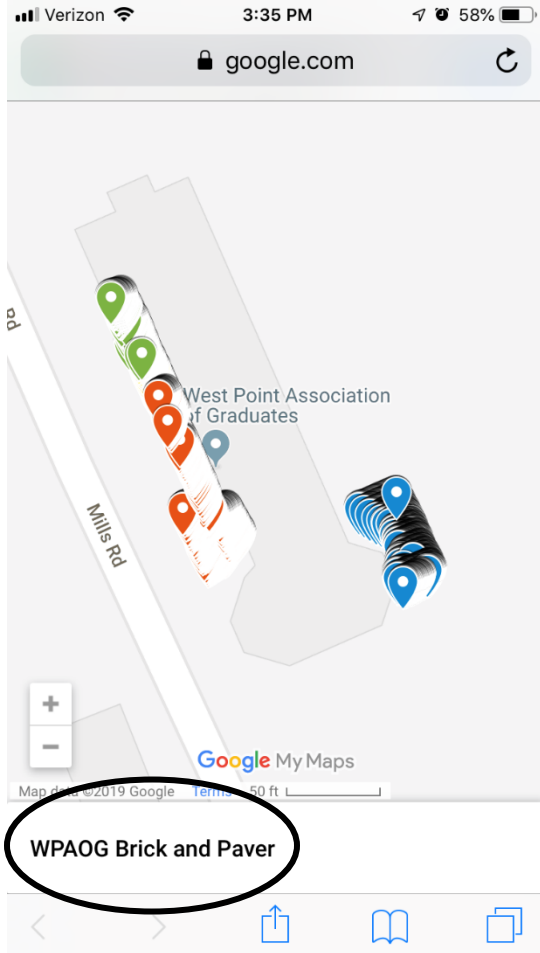
- The map will generate information about your brick and its general location. The brick you select will appear in a white circle.





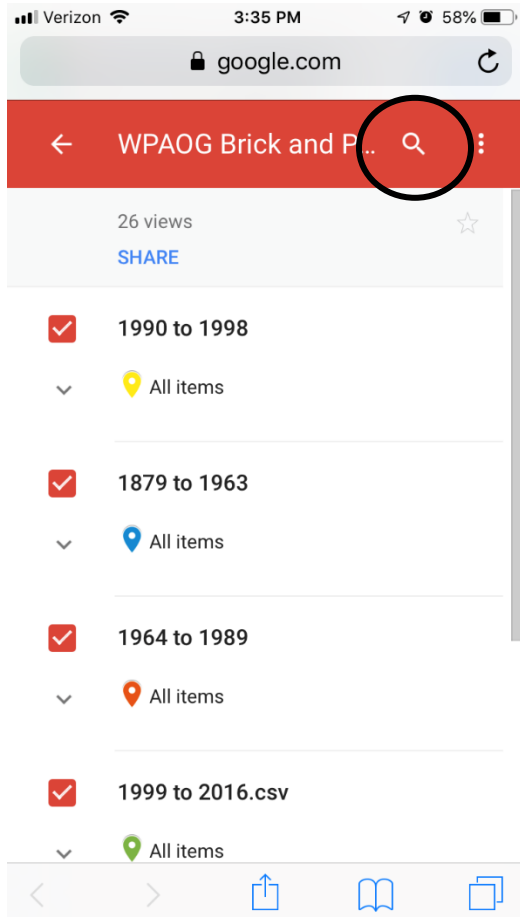
How to use the Brick and Paver search tool on a smart phone:

1. Select “Locate Your Brick” at <https://www.westpointaog.org/brickandpaver>. If clicking the link automatically takes you to Google Maps, press and hold “Locate your Brick” and select “Open” or “Open in New Tab.”
2. Click “WPAOG Brick and Paver” at the bottom of the screen.



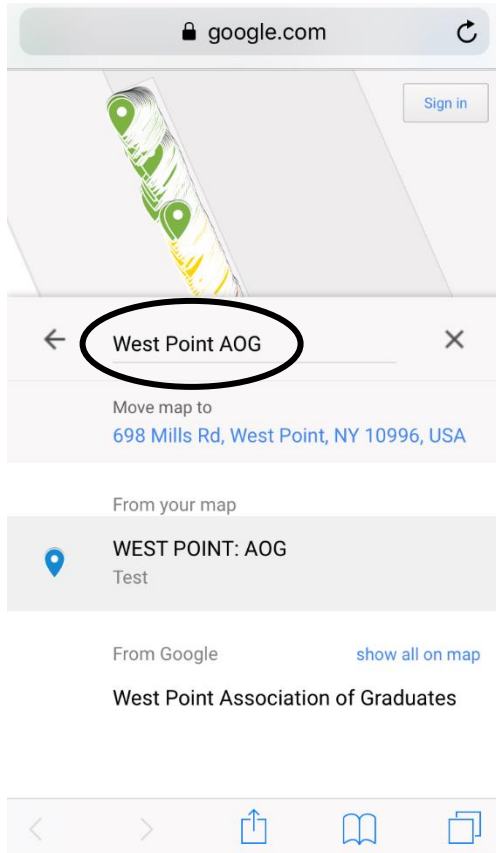


3. Tap on the magnifying glass in the upper left corner.



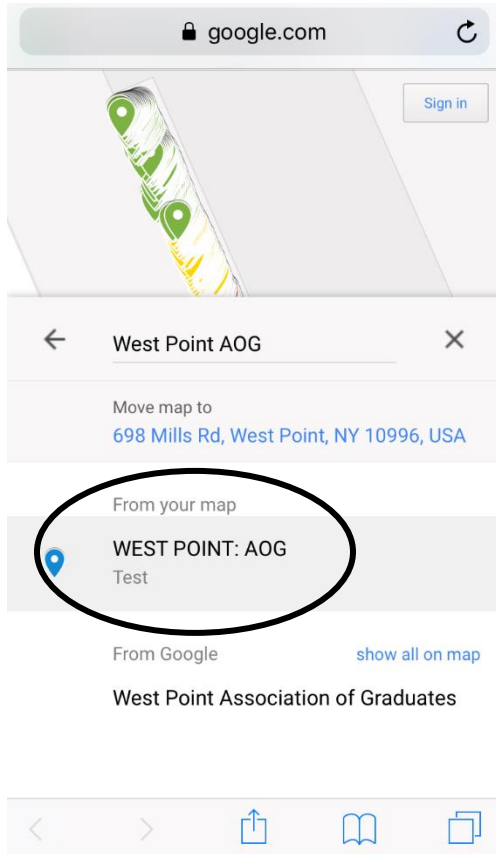


4. In the search bar, type the recipient last name or the inscription of the brick for which you are searching.



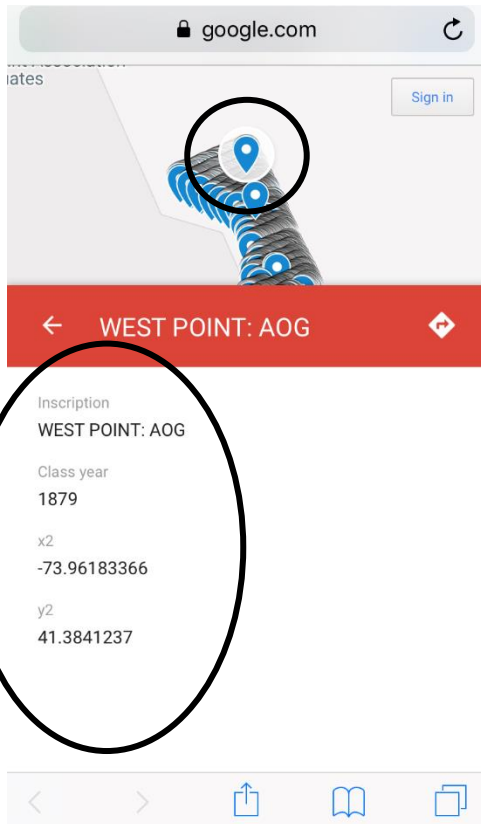


5. When you have typed the name or inscription you wish to search for, under “From your map” on the bottom of the screen, tap the name of the brick you wish to locate.



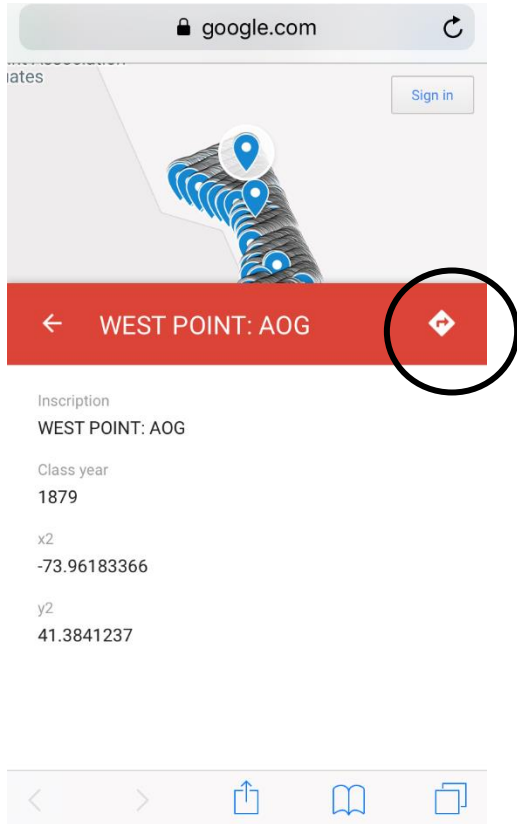


- The map will generate the information about your brick. The brick you select will appear in a white circle.



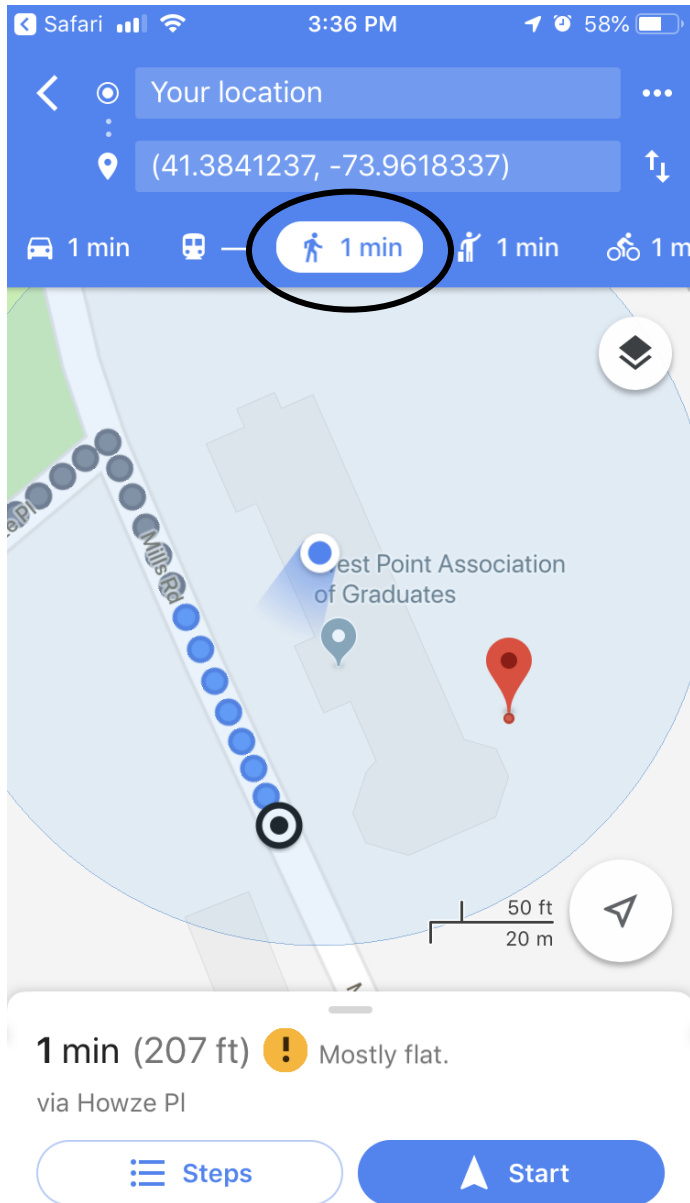


7. If you wish to get directions to your brick, tap the arrow icon near the name of the brick recipient.





8. Google maps will open. When prompted, you can launch the map in a Google Maps app if you have the app preinstalled. If you are near Herbert Hall, you can use Google Maps to find your location and get directions. Make sure you allow Google Maps to access your location and select walking directions.



The red dot indicates about where the brick is located. The map feature will allow you to get within the general area of your brick. You can also search for your brick within the class sections.
