In 1999, she departed active duty to pursue her civilian career. After America was attacked on 9/11, Brandi returned to military service and continues to serve in the Army Reserve as a senior Army Logistician. Some key highlights of her career include graduating from the Army War College, serving as the Chief of Staff for the 79th Theater Sustainment Command, and commanding the 451st Expeditionary Sustainment Command.
